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Invitation: Morro Bay Art Association invites you to participate in the annual **Art in the Park** festival in the quaint fishing village of Morro Bay, located on the central coast of California. The festival features 120 arts and crafts booths. Publicity is wide spread, and large crowds attend.

When: **Memorial Day** weekend, May 22, 23, 24 – Saturday, Sunday, Monday
Happy Birthday America weekend, July 3, 4, 5 - Saturday, Sunday, Monday
Labor Day Weekend, September 4, 5, 6, - Saturday, Sunday, Monday

Where: In **Morro Bay City Park** located on Morro Bay Blvd, Morro Bay, CA

Eligibility: The festival is open to original handmade arts and crafts. We will not accept applications for clothing, crocheted or other yarn goods, or dolls. Our goal is to have a show with variety – both in media and price range. No mass produced items, imports, or kits will be considered. The criteria for selections are quality, originality, diversity, and presentation. Each medium will be limited to assure a well-balanced show.

Booths: Each space will be 10' x 10' with the exception of some spaces on Morro Bay Blvd. and Pacific St. A white, easy up style canopy is required. Please, no pets, young children, or loud radios in your space during show hours. No electricity is available, and no generators are allowed.

Fees: The entry fee for an enclosed space is \$195, for a corner space, the fee is \$220. The fee includes \$10 Morro Bay Vendor fee. You do not need to send a separate check for the \$10 vendor fee. You must post date your check(s) 90 days prior to the show(s) you wish to enter. Example: Memorial Day Show check will be dated February 1, 2010.

Cancellations: Refunds will be issued one month prior to each show IF we can resell your space to another vendor. Any cancellation made within 30 days of the event will be charged the entry fee. These monies will have already been allocated for advertising and various production costs.

To Apply: Submit 3 photos of your work. All work should be represented and visibly obvious in your photos and listed on your application. One photo must show your entire booth with its contents, approximating how your booth will look at the Art in the Park festival. You do not need to submit photos if you participated in any 2009 Art in the Park festival. Put your name and address on the back of each photo. Include a self addressed, stamped envelope large enough and with adequate postage to return your photos. If this requirement is not followed, your photos will not be returned to you. In addition, send two business size, self addressed and stamped envelopes to be used to send you acknowledgment that your application has been received by us and results of jurying. (There are no additional spaces available for food vendors at this time.)

Deadline: All applications will be accepted until shows are filled.
